Gosford Cruise Report

The berths were booked, eskies filled and the flotilla set out on our Annual raid to Gosford Sailing Club. After last year's heart stopping moments under the Rip Bridge, the Commodore elected to take the "pocket rocket" 11 meter for sailing so the Admiral organized a berth on "Bad Habits" with Michael & Janelle (hot showers and a TV - pretty comfortable!).

"Jandu" was there to represent the cruising division with Hans & Elizabeth in fine form. "Incorrigible" was re-assembled in time for Darren, Sam and Thomas to make the voyage. Of course "Happy Hour" couldn't be held back, even though Bob was coughing and spluttering like a diesel engine running on salt water. Ian Lehman also joined us in his new cruising vessel so the fleet was complete.

After a rather uneventful voyage up to the Brisbane Waters we made our way to Gosford Sailing Club where Bob Swan made us welcome. AGM

Wednesday 13th June 2005 was the Annual General Meeting for Palm Beach Yacht Club. The turnout was down on what was expected. As you can see by the new committee we say farewell and thank you to several old committee members and welcome to the new committee members and a big thank you to those who have chosen to stay on.

Following three years of running at a loss, it was resolved at the meeting to increase the Race Entry Fee to \$ 85. This will help to cover our Insurance and Racing costs.

Considering most clubs that award prizes and trophies for every race charge over \$ 200 for a Race Entry fee, this still represents good value.

In addition, the membership fee has been raised to \$ 120 to cover the costs of the Club moorings. Also, keep in mind that this is the first fee increase in 5 years and has only been done to ensure our financial future as a club. Clearly we need to expand our membership base at the same time.

The next most important issue to come out of the meeting was a proposal to adopt the standard AYF starting sequence (which was introduced in 2000).

The new start procedure will be (5-4-1 go) i.e. five minute gun and flag followed by a four minute gun and flag followed by a 1 minute gun and flag followed lastly by the start gun and flag. Please note for the Twilight Season there will be a five minute gap between the Start gun for first division and the five minute gun for second division.

This standard procedure will come into effect for the first race of the Spring Series and the details will be included in the new Program and Sailing Instructions.

The other issue was that since we have lost Darrell and Rosemary Ford as our Sunday Race Starters, we will have to revert back to our old system of each boat taking a turn to do the start. This has already been started so we would like to take this opportunity to thank everybody who has already done a start (or in some cases more than one).

A volunteer roster will be sent out shortly so you can select which races you would like to help with.

21st Birthday

July 23 sees the 21^{st} Birthday of Palm Beach Yacht Club, so for members new and old and any in between here is a chance to dust of the party frocks and suits and leave the winter blues behind for an evening of fun and frivolity.
